

Triple Crown FUN!!!

There will be a few additional fun features tying the Pikes Peak Road Ascent closely with the Triple Crown of Running with some fun prizes to be presented at the Triple Crown awards ceremony in September. There will be an intermediate finish time provided at 10 miles to correspond with the distance of the Garden of the Gods 10-Mile, the first leg of the Triple Crown of Running. The two times will then be combined for the "10-mile Challenge." with awards presented at the Triple Crown awards ceremony held in September. Additionally, an "Ascent Challenge" will combine times from the Pikes Peak Ascent or ascent portion of the Pikes Peak Marathon and the Pikes Peak Road Ascent. There will also be a "Tripler Challenge" geared toward attracting the Pikes Peak Doublers (runners who completed the Pikes Peak Ascent and Marathon the weekend prior to the Pikes Peak Road Ascent), making these runners "Triplers."

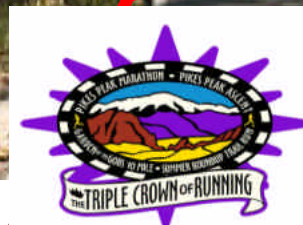

Introduction

The Inaugural Pikes Peak Road Ascent is under the auspices of Pikes Peak Marathon, Inc. This 11.6-mile running event starts at the Pikes Peak Toll Gate (7,750') and ascends to Glen Cove (11,425') at an average grade of 5-8%. The race is a fully-supported, competitive, CCR Timing chip-timed event (*you will receive your chip as a memento from the race*) giving runners the chance to experience a section of the Pikes Peak Highway which is closed to automobiles the day of the event, with the exception of official race and highway staff vehicles. The race is held concurrently with the 2nd Annual Assault on the Peak, a bike ride from Manitou Springs to the Summit of Pikes Peak. Since Pikes Peak — America's Mountain — is closed to bicycles and runners/walkers on every other day of the year this event is truly special for any cyclist or runner wanting to test their mettle as well as their lung capacity! A minimum of three (3) rest stops for runners with water, snacks, and restroom facilities, in route. Runner clothing will be transported to Glen Cove. Runners will be shuttled post-finish to the Toll Gate and/or designated parking areas. A post-event celebration will be held in Manitou Springs' Memorial Park with the bicyclists from Noon—4PM.

Entry Fee and Awards

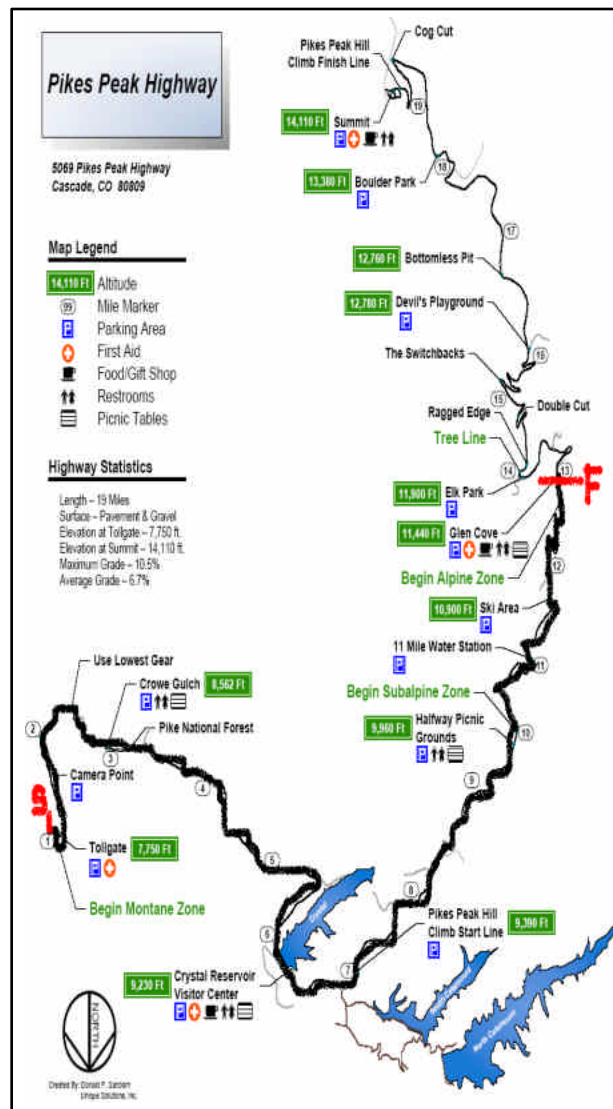
ENTRY FEE will be \$80 through June 30, \$95 July 1—July 31, \$110 from August 1-26, if space available, \$130 August 27, **no race day registration**. Field limited to 700. Fee includes membership to the American Trail Running Association, a commemorative shirt, bus transportation to the start line from designated parking areas in Manitou Springs and/or Cascade, transportation from Glen Cove finish area to start line and/or designated parking areas post event, post-race pasta meal (guests of runners \$8/person). Register by mail to: PPM, PO Box 333, Manitou Springs, CO 80829, online at www.imathlete.com, or in-store in Colorado Springs at the Runner's Roost, Colorado Running Company, or Boulder Running Company.

AWARDS CEREMONY will be held at 2PM in Manitou Springs' Memorial Park. Awards presented to top five male and top five female finishers overall with prize money \$250, \$200, \$150, \$100, \$50. Age group awards three deep starting at 16-19, 20-99 in five year increments. All finishers under 4 hours will receive a custom medal. Contact trlrunner@aol.com if questions.

Course and Parking

PARKING will be available at several locations with shuttle busing to the start line starting at 6:30 a.m. Parking details available by early July. Spectators must pay \$5/person for shuttle to Glen Cove. Limited parking near the start area. Carpooling recommended.

After the event, runners will not be permitted to run down the road. During the race, runners will stay on the right side of the road. This will be a closed course, not open to runners or walkers who are not registered in the race. Absolutely no dogs, baby strollers, or headphones permitted.

LIABILITY WAIVER AND AGREEMENT, 2011, Triple Crown of Running/
Pikes Peak Road Ascent

1. I understand and assume all risks of injury to my person which may occur while competing in the Pikes Peak Road Ascent of the Pikes Peak Marathon, Inc. and/or the American Trail Running Association and I, for myself and for my heirs, executor, administrator, personal representative, and assigns, do hereby forever waive and release all rights and claims for direct or indirect damages or losses, whether monetary or otherwise compensatory which I may have against any and all individuals, and indemnify them for all claims, damages, judgments, costs of whatever nature and form. 2. I am advised that the following are some but not all of the special conditions and factors which may be encountered in the Pikes Peak Road Ascent and that there may be other hazards:

- Course elevation is more than 6400 feet above mean sea level, with attendant low humidity. -The Pikes Peak Road Ascent course is on paved streets with possible potholes, cracks, debris, curbs, abrupt shoulders, and gravel on road surfaces, and some dirt/gravel sections - Those persons on the Pikes Peak Road Ascent course after 12:00 pm may encounter unrestricted vehicular traffic and bicycles on the same roadway and during the race runners may encounter emergency-vehicle traffic on the course. 3. I attest that I am in good physical condition and mentally capable of participating in the race for which I am registering and that any and all questions about the race, including but not limited to the dangers of participating in said event, have been satisfactorily answered. I also acknowledge that should I require transport to a medical facility that I must pay for such transportation and any treatment provided. I further agree to abide by requests of race officials on matters concerning race operations. 4. I hereby grant full permission to any and all of the foregoing, whether named or unnamed entities, to use my name, picture, or likeness on any media or form and any other record of my participating in any or all events for any publicity and/or promotional purposes without obligation to me or my successors, assigns, et al., or liability by the publisher or promoter. I understand my name and address may be provided to sponsors for the purpose of product promotion and marketing. 5. I have read this entry form and certify my understanding of and compliance with such by my signature. 6. Conduct on my part, which a Race Director deems unsportsmanlike, will be grounds for immediate disqualification and denial of further participation in that and subsequent races organized by the Pikes Peak Marathon. 7. I agree not to bring or otherwise have animals on the course. 8. I understand that the race entry fees paid by or for me are non-refundable unless the registrar refuses entry. The non-refund policy also applies to any cancellation of the race for weather or other circumstances. 9. I understand that providing false personal information on my age is grounds for disqualification and being barred from future PPM races. 10. I agree to comply with the rules and regulations of the race. 11. I agree not to give, sell, assign or otherwise transfer or convey my official race number to any other persons.
